## Shriner's Healthcare for Children Twin Cities:

The hospital in Mpls has been sold to the U of M for 22.5 million. We as a board are happy with that amount. The sale still needs ratification from the U's Board of Regents.

It is going to become a treatment and research center for childhood brain issues including autism. This makes us VERY Happy that the house we built will continue to help kids.

We expect to move into our new 18K square foot clinic in June. The location is 215 Radio Drive in Woodbury, on the east edge of the TC's, just off I-94. We will have the entire first floor and another tenant is to be determined. The entire area is populated by medical services.

As a board, we are concerned about information going out to the general public. We have battled half reporting from some of the TC's media in the past and are on guard for that going forward. Because of this, we ask for your help.

We encourage all Nobles & Ladies to "like" the Facebook pages of the Shriners Hospitals for Children in general and especially Shriners Healthcare Twin Cities.

There have been reposts of some very old and inaccurate stories concerning our hospital and the entire system. For this reason, please do not post anything that does not come from these Shriner's sources, my FB page or a post from a Shriner Family/Patient.

Illustrious Sturlaugson heard from someone that we don't treat scoliosis anymore. That was news to his family. A repost from a Shriner carries extra weight so we need to be accurate.

We are hoping to have a live camera link on the construction site for us to access. My wish is to have it live on one of the TVs by the time we roast Pote Rick.

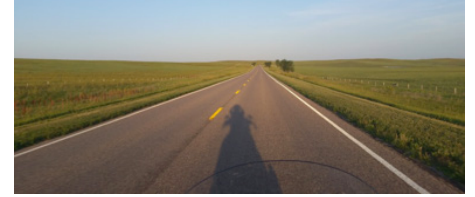
Those items are still valued in our new model, but I do want to emphasize that the greatest impact, and greatest need, continues to be financial support for wheelchairs and related accessories.
