325.11 Election Regulations of the Imperial Code

(a) Electioneering. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a résumé consisting of his educational background, his vocational history and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.

(b) Expenditures Prohibited. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited. (c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.

(d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing



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Bismarck **Outreach Clinic** With Healthcare, Change Is Inevitable

Greetings! This fall we held two Shrine Outreach Clinics. Normally, we have a fall Shrine screening clinic but due to good old ND weather canceling our screening clinic in April, we held two make up Outreach Clinics.

On September 12, we saw 28 children with expenses of \$1064.24 or \$38.01 per kiddo. Kem-5; El Zagal-9; Al Bedoo-1; Naja-1

On October 17, we saw 43 kiddos with expenses of \$1162.20 or \$27.03 each. As of this writing we do not have temple breakdowns.

As you can see, we have saved a nice amount of our transportation fund by having these Outreach

Most of you do not know this, but we are working on a new contract for days and space with the Bone & Joint Clinic. The outlook goal will be to have a screening clinic every other month in Bismarck at B&J on a Thursday. We currently have two doctors that would take turns coming and bringing with them 3 POPS, 1 nurse and 1 registration person.

Moving along to 2020, the next goal will be telehealth. This will allow the staff to stay in MN but screen patients with a qualified individual here in Bismarck.

Healthcare is forever a revolving door and we must go through that door to see what is on the other side. It may be frightful, it may not work, but we need to try!

The hospital staff looks forward to coming to Bismarck on an every other month basis because we are so organized. Many thanks go out to all those people who help make these days possible. If it was not for these people's insight, input and thought-and most of all time, we would not be able to do this ourselves. So we thank all of you, for all you do, to support the Bismarck Screening Clinic; to keep it on the radar for them to keep coming here in the future.

This year there will be only 1 game that will cost


